



By way of our partnerships, community and stakeholders, CEF is able to promote excellence in education, lifelong learning and responsible citizenship for CUSD students.

IMPACT CHANDLER SCHOLARS

IMPACT Chandler Scholars (ICS) is a recognition and/or reward program for Chandler Unified School District high school students. Students who complete the program by demonstrating academic excellence, exemplary attendance, and a commitment to service in the community over four years of high school often qualify for scholarship and financial aid opportunities their senior year. IMPACT Chandler Scholars are unique in that they are prepared academically to succeed in college while understanding and embracing what it means to be committed and active citizens. Students are given the opportunity to enroll as freshmen during an open enrollment period in the fall. They are asked to achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or better, a cumulative attendance rate of 95% or higher, and complete at least 100 hours of community service after enrolling in the program. Upon completion of these criteria their senior year, ICS students will have the opportunity to apply for a competitive \$1,000 ICS Scholarship by reflecting in an essay, how their community service work impacted them, their community, and how it will impact their future. **The class of 2016 received 70 scholarships totalling \$70,000.**

Recognition Reception \$210,000 Awarded

Over \$210,000 in scholarship dollars were awarded to donor scholarship recipients and ICS Scholars from all high schools at the annual Recognition Reception held at The Ashley Castle! These students were recognized by CEF donors, Board of Directors and community members.

After the funds are raised from the August 100% Awareness Campaign, volunteers hop on school buses to deliver the "surprise" good news to all the CUSD teachers and schools who were awarded a grant. In 15/16 the Foundation awarded over \$61,000 in teacher and school grants impacting over 22,000 students and 258 teachers.

CHANDLER CARE CENTER

The Chandler CARE Center's Children's Medical and Dental Clinics provide CUSD students in need with access to vital medical and dental services that help ensure their health and wellness are maintained so that they are healthy enough to attend school and focus on their education. The strength of our programs is a testament to the incredible support from our community, schools, funders and volunteers.

CUSD STUDENT CRISIS FUND

Established to provide assistance to students facing serious life altering illness or injuries, the Student Crisis Fund is a testament to our community's dedication to all of its children, especially those in need. Because families can experience substantial medical costs not covered through insurance, the Chandler Unified School District and the Chandler Education Foundation partnered in 2006 to create the Student Crisis Fund. CEF has since assisted families with over \$224,000 in medical bills and other related expenses.

Dear CEF,

Thank you so much for your generous grant to our Hartford Mariachi Ensemble! Our program is a division of the Desert Sounds Mariachi, and we are very fortunate to have a dedicated, hardworking group of 12 students to start off our first year. Our group has performed at school and in public, and they have garnered much attention. We Huskies are very proud to have our own mariachi ensemble, and many students have expressed interest in joining next year!

Finding dedicated, enthusiastic students who love and want to learn mariachi wasn't the challenge for us—finding enough instruments was our real challenge! The basic mariachi band has approximately 6 violins, 2 trumpets, 2-3 guitars and vihuelas, and 1 guitarron. Violins, trumpets and guitars are easy to find—vihuelas and guitarrons are not. That is where your grant money helped us—above is a picture of the guitarron (left) and the vihuela (right) that you purchased for us!

Having those instruments gives the group a very real, authentic sound and experience. It makes our group sound professional and legitimate, and we will forever have those instruments at Hartford for future students to use and enjoy. Our goal is to increase our inventory of guitarrons and vihuela so that we have enough to support 2 or even 3 separate ensembles: beginning, intermediate, and advanced mariachi!

With the help of your award, we can turn our dreams of growing our mariachi program into a reality. Our mariachi students love to perform, and their friends love to listen to them perform. Mariachi showcases our students' talents while exposing and connecting them to their history and culture, which makes our program truly unique and special. Thank you so much for your generosity, we hope to play for you someday soon!

DESTINATION COLLEGE

Chandler Education Foundation (CEF), City of Chandler, and the Chandler Gilbert Community College provides 150 students from CUSD Title 1 schools a college experience that they may otherwise not receive. The partners provide an experience to these students that helps them realize that college is attainable and gets them excited for the opportunity. The students are fed breakfast, lunch, and bussed to CGCC for three weeks in the summer where they experience their first taste of college classes. These classes are modified and cover topics such as computer literacy, math, nutrition, wellness and more. Students also have the opportunity to hear from guest speakers representing a variety of careers. The program is run completely on in kind and monetary donations from stakeholders, businesses, and corporations that are vested in the Chandler community.



The Lifelong Learning grant gave me the resources I needed to start my masters in Educational Leadership. LIFELONG LEARNING LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP FOR CUSD TEACHERS

The Chandler Education Foundation (CEF) is proud to support our exemplary CUSD teachers seeking higher education by providing a Lifelong Learning Legacy Scholarship through various fundraising initiatives conducted by CEF. Oftentimes, the greatest barrier between teachers seeking National Board Certification, Masters, PhD, Special Education endorsement or Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (S.T.E.M) certifications is the high cost to complete the program. Lifelong Learning Legacy Scholarships are awarded up to \$1,000 annually to approved recipients. Teachers can reapply for up to one consecutive year to renew the scholarship. CEF awarded a little more than \$18,000 in scholarships to teachers this past year.

TEACHER MINI GRANTS

Innovative teaching and learning is one of CEF's guiding values and we are proud to provide funding for outstanding educational projects. Funds raised from the annual 100% Awareness Campaign are used to award mini grants to CUSD teachers and schools to help maintain high curriculum standards. Without these grants, many teachers would not have sources of funding or would have to use their own funds to support their classroom projects. Since 2006, CEF has awarded over \$411,000 to teachers and schools in the form of mini grants.

COMMUNITY AND PRIVATE DONOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Through the generosity of our community and donors, CEF administers and awards scholarships annually to students from the Chandler Unified School District. These scholarships enrich and enhance the lives of our students. The Chandler Education Foundation believes in helping our students continue to succeed, even as they graduate on to college.

Fundraising with a Purpose

100% Awareness Campaign-\$89,601

The Chandler Education Foundation's distinctive 100% Awareness program gets everyone involved! Every student and staff member in the Chandler Unified School District is asked to contribute in support of our schools and students. The dollars raised are used to award teacher mini grants to CUSD staff who would not otherwise have sources of funding or who would have to use their own money to support classroom projects.

Golf Tournament- \$72,738

The 14th Annual Golf Tournament held once again at Whirlwind Golf Club was another huge success with almost 300 golfers in attendance. The tournament raises public awareness of the Chandler Education Foundation and its goals, promotes the cause of public education and provides funds for grants for teachers and scholarships for students. When the business community supports the tournament, they participate in educating the workforce of tomorrow.

Winner's Choice Car/Cash Raffle-\$101,980

Each year the Foundation partners with Big Two Toyota of Chandler and Toyota Financial Services to raise significant funds for education through raffle ticket sales. By purchasing a raffle ticket, investors have the opportunity to win either a brand new Toyota vehicle or \$20,000 in cash. Because of the generosity of our supporters and stakeholders we are able to help fund programs including teacher and school grants, student scholarships and Lifelong Learning Legacy Scholarship for educators.




